Central Community Health Centre is currently seeking Drivers to drive our mobile clinic to locations throughout Elgin County and assist with various tasks while the clinics are taking place. You, as a Driver, will make it possible for CCHC to bring medical and other health and wellness services to people living in smaller communities who might not otherwise be able to access them. These services include medical treatment, flu shots, children's fluoride treatments, blood pressure checks and education, diabetic footcare, and help accessing other services in the area. Many of the people who access these services are individuals who face barriers to accessing quality health care including seniors and people with disabilities. As a Driver, you will have a significant positive impact on the health and wellbeing of the people throughout the County.



What You'll Do

- Drive the mobile clinic to communities throughout Elgin County, in a safe and courteous manner, arriving on time and complying with all traffic regulations
- Ensure the mobile clinic is maintained in good working order by regularly checking common fluid levels and other minor vehicle checks
- Greeting and assisting clients as needed (including use of the clinic's lift)
- Provide staff and clients with other assistance as needed
- Completing simple paperwork

What You'll Bring and Who You Are

- 28 years of age or older with a minimum of five years driving experience
- Hold a valid "G" driver's license and a clean driving record for three years minimum
- Be in good physical and mental health with no health conditions that may impair ability to drive safely (vision, hearing, perception, reflexes, certain medications, etc.)
- Show initiative when dealing with potentially long waiting times
- Mechanically inclined and could confidently perform vehicle checks and minor maintenance
- Experience owning and driving recreational vehicles a definite asset
- Be willing to drive without distractions (cell phone, texting, eating while driving)
- Friendly, caring and compassionate.
- Comfortable interacting with people who are from diverse backgrounds that are different from your own
- Strong oral communication skills
- Punctual and reliable
